

Boiler Operator / Utility Operator

JOB DUTIES:

Steam/utility operators are responsible for the efficient, effective and safe operation of the steam plant, mill water, effluent, fire systems, and compressed air systems.

Responsibilities include:

- Inventory, order and receive boiler and water treatment chemicals
- Monitor the mill's steam and condensate systems
- Fire and tend the two 210 PSI high-pressure gas-fired boilers 4
- Monitor effluent water system and adjust with chemicals to meet environmental requirements
- Monitor, adjust and operate the sludge de-watering press for optimal performance.

To perform all tasks and functions in Steam/Utilities, including;

• Control of two-(2) gas-fired boilers: perform inspection rounds, conduct water chemistry tests, work with computer controls, evaluate paper machine demands and adjust steam boilers. Including monitoring, inspect and adjusting controls for the steam, condensate filtered water, fire, effluent, and air supply system for mill use.

Operate company truck to drive to off factory locations monitoring effluent system to the river, clarifier water treatment process, chemical treatment of processed water.

Work in both inside and outside environments subject to prevailing local weather conditions. Position may include walking up to 8 miles a day and several flights of stairs.

HOURS:

Operators work a 12-hour rotating schedule consistent with the mill's master schedule. This schedule is on a 28-day rotation of 5 days on, 5 days off, 4 days on followed by 5 off, 5 on, 4 off. The on periods are either all days shifts, then rotating to all-night shifts.

REQUIREMENTS:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid driver's license to drive company vehicle
- Skills to obtain knowledge and understanding of process chemicals and their uses
- Pass drug and background checks



ADDITIONAL DETAILS:
