

## **Steam Utility Operator**

### **Summary of Key Requirements:**

Steam/utility operators are responsible for the efficient, effective and safe operation of the steam plant, mill water, effluent, fire systems and compressed air systems. This includes:

1. Inventory: order and receive boiler and water treatment chemicals
2. Monitor the mill's steam and condensate systems
3. Monitor processed water and effluent water stream and adjust with chemicals to meet environmental requirements
4. Monitor, adjust and operate the sludge de-watering press for optimal performance.
5. Must be able to work independently as well in a team environment.
6. Utility Operator completes rounds of the entire factory and mill property

### **Essential Functions:**

- Safely operate and optimize equipment systems
- Read and interpret information from various sources or written communications and computer operated systems and trends.
- Apply statistical process control techniques to troubleshoot and control process parameters.
- Operate forklift, grab trucks and company pickup.
- Receive and manage bulk chemicals.
- Perform water chemistry tests.
- Use small hand tools and perform minor maintenance process equipment.
- Housekeeping and monthly safety inspections.
- Operate department and meet all environmental permit requirements.

### **Special Requirements of the Job:**

- Work in both inside and outside environments.
- Able to work alone with limited supervision.
- Able to work on short notice if required to fill-in for temporary absences.
- Must possess a valid personal driver's license to operate company truck to drive to off factory locations monitoring effluent system to river, clarifier water treatment process and chemical treatment of processed water.
- Able to work 12 hour, rotating shifts including weekends and nights.

An example of this schedule would be working 5 days, followed by five days off, then working 4 nights, followed by 5 days off, then working 5 days followed by 4 days off. This rotating schedule covers 28 days (14 days off, for 14 days worked) and all employees get two weekends off a month

### **Additional Details:**

We offer a competitive starting wage of \$21.46/hr. Overtime rates (\$32.19/hr) apply for hours worked over 10 hours in a work day, or after 40 hours a week, whichever is greater.
